ELECTION AS A CHARTERED GEOLOGIST

I am pleased to inform you that you were elected as a Chartered Geologist of the Geological Society today. You are now entitled to use the designatory letters CGeol FGS after your name. A Certificate confirming your status as a Chartered Geologist will be sent under separate cover. Please note that your Chartered Geologist status is only valid if you maintain Fellowship. I would also like to draw your attention to our Code of Conduct (<https://www.geolsoc.org.uk/codeofconduct>).

Following Chartership you may be eligible for further Professional Qualifications. These are European Geologist (EurGeol); inclusion on the Register of Ground Engineering Professionals; Specialist in Land Condition (SiLC). You can find links to these and information on how to apply for them on the Society's Website by going to: (<https://www.geolsoc.org.uk/Membership/Chartership-and-Professional/Post-Chartership-Qualifications>).

As a Chartered Fellow you are also eligible to obtain and use the [CGeol Logo and Stamp](#).

Please note that as a Chartered Geologist it is now compulsory to complete a Continuing Professional Development (CPD) record annually. This should either be done via the Society's online system, (www.geolsoc.org.uk/cpd) or an alternative mode compatible with the requirements laid out in our online scheme. Also, please note the possibility of your CPD record being audited regularly.


